16/161 Apologies for Absence

No apologies required.

16/162 Declaration of Interests and Requests for Dispensation

No interests were declared and no requests for dispensation had been received.

16/163 Minutes of Meeting held on 15th September 2016

The minutes of the meeting were approved by the councillors and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

16/164 Reports from County and District Councillors and Suffolk Constabulary

Councillors reviewed Gordon Jones previously circulated report. Councillors reviewed John Ward's previously circulated report and discussed CIL and planning issues.

16/165 Reports and Question from Councillors and Chairman's Report

The Clerk was asked to look at the conditions to two recent developments in the village and if necessary discuss with Babergh if further action is required. The Chairman raised the proposal she had received from neighbouring parishes on running jointly funded SALC planning training sessions.

16/166 Reports and Questions from Parishioners

Mel Harvey outlined her role as Babergh's Community Officer for Polstead and discussed the implications of the current BT consultation on the 4 public phone boxes in Polstead. Mr Lay outlined his application for a dwelling on Stackwood Road, although at this stage no plans were available for councillors.

16/170 Finance

a. All cheques signed and due for signing, as itemised in the RFO Report (Appendix C), were authorised by the councillors. The councillors also noted the income received since the last meeting, agreed the Reconciliation of Accounts against the Bank Statements and reviewed the Statement of Accounts against the budget.

16/171 Highways and Footpaths

The rutted condition of the Heath Road to Sprotts Farm footpath will be raised with the landowner by Cllrs Oxford and MacWillson.

16/172 Assets, allotments, playground and playing field

The Clerk had communicated with the tenant of the allotment not used in 2016 and he has agreed not to renew the tenancy in 2017 and the councillors agreed that the Clerk gives notice to the tenant. There are now 2 allotment plots available for 2017. The councillors agreed with the Clerk's calculation to charge each of the 11 tenants in 2016 £5 for water usage.

16/173 Defibrillator

The councillors reviewed the quotation from JA Griggs for the work to provide an electric supply to and the installation of the defibrillator cabinet at the Village Hall and resolved to allocate the contract to him at a cost of £260. PPC will also give the VHC a sum of £30 a year to cover electricity use. Cllr Peck's wife and mother have agreed to undertake the governance requirements of the defibrillator scheme. A session for residents interested to know how the defibrillator works will also be arranged.

16/174 BT Phone Boxes

The councillors will consider the adoption of the Polstead phone boxes, earmarked for decommissioning by BT, at the November meeting.

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16/175 SALC consultation

The councillors will send the responses on the SALC consultation on public services to the Clerk for his collation and response on behalf of PPC.

16/176 Precept consultation

The councillors noted that the Government's precept consultation proposed to set the referendum limit for a 2% increase for councils with a Band D precept of more than £75 and a total precept of more than £500,000 and resolved that no response was required at this time.

16/177 Christmas 2016

Cllr Peck will source the Christmas Tree again this year. The Christmas Carols will follow the Church Service on Sunday 18th December, and be held in the Village Hall starting at 4.30pm.

16/178 Footpaths Event 2017

Deferred to the January meeting.

16/179 Neighbourhood Watch

The councillors reviewed the vacancy for a Neighbourhood Watch co-ordinator for Polstead and with no person identified for the role, will keep a watching brief on the situation.

16/180 BDC Meeting

Cllrs Flather and Wigglesworth with represent PPC at the forthcoming event.

16/181 Future Agenda Items

16/182 Standing Order 3d

In accordance to PPC's Standing Order 3d the councillors resolved that the public and press be excluded from the meeting due to the confidential nature of the co-option of a councillor.

16/183 Councillor Vacancy

The councillors discussed the councillor vacancy with Andrew Wade and the skills that he could offer the council. The councillor resolved unanimously to co-opt Andrew Wade as a member of PPC and asked the Clerk to undertake the necessary work with Andrew and Babergh so that he could take up his role from the November meeting.
